**Let's be persistent in our prayers**. Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out. (Ephesians6; verse18-The Message).

The Persecuted Church. Christian children are often "on the frontline" of discrimination and persecution. For minority Christian children in countries around the world, school is often a place where they face hostility and pressure to convert to the majority religion. Many other Christian children come from families who are trapped in poverty due to anti-Christian discrimination, and can't afford to send them to school. Pray for the children of persecuted Christian families, and especially for their children. Ask that the Lord will lighten their path to grow up to be strong in their faith. Ask Him to be their Protector and their Comforter in the face of danger, and enable them to break free from the cycle of poverty and illiteracy in a safe and nurturing environment.

**Give thanks and pray** for those we know who are away this coming week, and for families being able to get together again for the first time in a long time. Pray that people will be sensible in what they do. Give thanks for the continuing reduction of Covid infections and deaths in this country. and that further easing of restrictions in stage 4 of the Government's road map from 21st June will be possible. Pray also that in other countries, where people are suffering from increased numbers of Covid infections and deaths, that governments and health services will work together to improve their situations.

Our Schools: Last Sunday we joined with Leighfields Evangelical Church to do a prayer walk around our local schools (and also the care homes). Most of the following prayer pointers were given to us by one of the schools. Pray for teachers and pupils as they enjoy a restorative break during this half-term week; for health and energy for the weeks ahead; for health for the families, some of whom have serious health situations; for wisdom in interpreting the guidance and making safe and sensible decisions; for understanding and compassion when things are stressful; for strength for staff to continue to maintain the protocols after such a long time; for wisdom for schools leadership as they navigate changes ahead; and for those young people who've done assessments over the last few weeks rather than the usual GCSE's.

**In EBC, give thanks** that as Government restrictions are eased, that we are becoming enabled to open up more activities, as well as developing new ministries. Pray that God will guide suitable candidates to us in response to our application for inclusion in the Pastoral Vacancy List.

**Continue to pray** for the health and circumstances of so many in our church fellowship, our families and friends. Pray for those who continue to be sad, anxious or worried, and those who are wary of going out. May they have the comfort of friendship, and the deep peace of knowing they are loved."
