FOR OUR PRAYER TIMES

Let's be persistent in our prayers. Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out.

(Ephesians 6: 18-The Message). In these times of uncertainty, continue to recognise that God is central, that true stability can only be found in Him, and pray that we be given the eye of faith that sees beyond uncertainties to the certainties: the things hoped for and the things unseen (Hebrews 11: 1).

The Persecuted Church. Eritrea is a country in northeast Africa with a population of around 3.2 million. It is one of the worst countries in the world for Christian persecution. Imprisoned Christians are tortured, starved and forced into hard labour. Conditions are worse for pastors and theological students who are singled out for beatings or have their jail terms extended as a warning to others. Many Christians are held indefinitely, often without trial, not knowing when they will be released. Some are kept in shipping containers, where they are exposed to the searing desert heat by day, and cold by night. Ask the Lord to strengthen Christians and bring healing and restoration to those released from prison, especially those who have no home to return to. Pray that the hearts of the authorities will soften to release more imprisoned Christians and allow believers of all denominations to worship freely.

Staff working in the adult social care sector. With both an ageing population and individuals of all ages with more complex needs that require additional social care support, there is an increasing requirement to recruit and retain staff doing this work. Pray that the profile of the social care sector will be raised, so as to attract the many additional people who are needed to work in these roles.

Covid 19: pray for wisdom as we move towards a full easing on the 19th. May we all learn to take responsibility for our own actions whilst being thoughtful about how this might impact others. Pray that those who are fearful may be encouraged to do a little more in safety. Let us, as church family, set a good example in all our decision making.

In EBC: continue to pray for those who are unwell, that they may rest in the care of our Lord as they receive treatment and support. For those taking a break may they have a time of rest and relaxation, with journeying mercies and safety for those who are travelling-whether in this country or further afield.

For the plans that God has for us as a church let's pray for clarity and a willingness to follow His leading whilst giving thanks for all that is currently happening.
