#### FOR OUR PRAYER TIMES

**Let's be persistent in our prayers.** Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out (Ephesians 6:18-The Message)

**Afghanistan**. Now that the Taliban has taken over the country and the occupying forces have left, pray that the new forming government there will be prepared to live peaceably, not just within their own borders, but with other countries. As converts from Islam, Afghan Christians will be even more vulnerable under Taliban rule than under the deposed Afghan government. If they are discovered they will probably be given the choice: convert, leave or be killed. Pray that God will be their shield and their fortress. Pray also that Afghans who have been evacuated to this country will find security and comfort in their new homes, and will feel welcome in their new communities.

**Continue to pray for Haiti,** struggling to recover from the recent earthquake there. Pray that aid agencies will increasingly be able to bring assistance, and that God will move mightily in this situation, and bring relief and comfort to this troubled country. Pray that the recent reports about **Climate Change,** and the many extreme weather events recently, will weigh heavily when countries meet at the COP26 conference in Glasgow in November, that that will be a catalyst for real action to take place. Pray that developed countries will be prepared to help other countries to have their industrial revolutions, using modern technology to enable movement away from fossil fuels. Pray that God will guide each of us to finding ways, maybe small ways, to turn this around before it is too late for future generations.

**Covid19 in this country.** Pray for wisdom from Government, other bodies, businesses, and all of us, as we continue to live with this virus. Pray that some recent problems in the supply chain ( due to people being unable to work because of Covid rules), especially with essential foodstuffs, will be eased. Pray that as people begin to see GP's again, that the number of appointments, and necessary onward referrals, will not overwhelm the system. Pray also that the current shortage of facility for blood tests will soon be eased.

As our children and young adults start or return to their studies in schools, colleges and universities, pray that this will become easier following the easing of Covid restrictions, and that those children who fell behind in their studies during the lockdowns will be able to catch up with their studies.

may rest in God's care as they receive treatment and support. As we start to be able to do more, thank God for enabling us to meet at our normal Sunday services, and to start the tea services again.. Thank God that the easing of restrictions is encouraging our regular, and some new, hirers to start their sessions. We pray today for Annette and her family and ask divine protection over her as she witnesses her faith may she grow in her relationship with Jesus and be kept safe.
