## FOR OUR PRAYER TIMES

Let's be persistent in our prayers. Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out (Ephesians 6:18-The Message)

Our prayers may be awkward. Our attempts may be feeble. But since the power of prayer is in the One who hears it and not in the one who says it, our prayers do make a difference (Max Lucado). By the time you read this the **COP26** conference in Glasgow will be well under way, and the news will be full of information about the sad situation our planet is in. I would ask you all to read as much as you can about this, and then pray, not just about governments around the world making decisions which will move us towards improving the world which our Lord created, but also to look at the many small things each of us can do to improve each of our carbon footprints, for the benefit of future generations. We have seen the devastating effects that Covid 19 has had. but the long term effects of Climate Change look to be far worse and ,unless things are done soon, it may be too late. You may think that the problem is too big, that the mountain is too high. But remember this

-You can't climb a mountain unless you make the first step -When faced with a large project, you move a mountain one stone at a time

-Every mountain top is within reach if you just keep climbing -As Jesus says in Matthew 17 verse 20: "I tell you the truth, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

**Covid 19.** Pray for all the countries in the world where Covid 19 is being suffered by so many people. Pray that Governments and people of influence will work increasingly together to share their collective knowledge, experience and wealth, so that everyone can benefit from the vaccines and protocols which are necessary to beat this disease. In this country, pray for wisdom from our Government and all of us, as we live with Covid 19, and be thankful that booster and flu vaccinations are now readily available for the most vulnerable.

**TWAM (**Tools With A Mission). A container will be loaded in Ipswich this week, ready for departure for Zimbabwe next week. Pray that all the toolkits requested can be sent in this container, and that any shortages of tools will be supplied.

**In this country**. Pray for those who are struggling. The effects of the pandemic has created and worsened many physical, emotional, mental, economic and social problems. Pray that God will move mightily in these situations, and bring hope and peace of mind. Pray that current shortages in supply chains will be eased. Pray for the many families who are facing financial and accommodation difficulties at this time, and now face the likelihood of increased fuel, food and other bills.

**In EBC**, continue to pray for all those who are unwell, in body or in spirit, that they may rest in God's care as they receive treatment and support. Thank God that the easing of restrictions is enabling and encouraging more use of our church building. Pray for the success of our AGM and member's meeting today, and for the plans that God has for our church, and thank Him for his continued guidance in our search for a new minister.
