These will be regularly prayed for by the Leadership Team and Prayer Team. We encourage you to make use of it.

FOR OUR PRAYER TIMES

Let's be persistent in our prayers. Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out (Ephesians 6:18-The Message)

Our prayers may be awkward. Our attempts may be feeble. But since the power of prayer is in the One who hears it and not in the one who says it, our prayers do make a difference (Max Lucado). **Refugees**. Pray for all refugees in the world today. Pray especially at this time for the thousands of refugees on the border between Belarus and Poland, seemingly being used, in the depths of their despair, as a political weapon. Pray also for wisdom for the European Union as they discuss the wide issues concerning refugees, and that our Government and other countries around the world will have a voice in these discussions.

Persecuted Church. The charity Open Doors issue a World Watch map every year showing which countries are most involved in persecuting our Christian brothers and sisters. These reports consistently show year after year that North Korea is probably the most dangerous place in the world to be a Christian. Some have been executed for the "crime" of owning a Bible, and many thousands incarcerated in political labour camps. Three generations have been punished for the "crime" of one Christian family member. Pray for daily grace for Christians there, who are in danger every moment. May all facing death, torture and abuse in labour camps know God's sustaining power. Pray that God will protect our brothers and sisters as they meet in utmost secrecy; may they hear your loving voice giving them wisdom and strength.

Pray for all **the countries in the world where Covid 19** is being suffered by so many people, including the effects of long Covid. Pray that Governments and people of influence will work increasingly together, so that everyone can benefit from the vaccines which are necessary to beat this disease. Pray especially at this time that necessary restrictions in this country and around the world are applied, and accepted, to curb additional infections in respect of the newly identified Covid variant, Omicron. Pray that plans for families and friends being able to meet in the lead up to, and at Christmas, will be undisturbed.

In this country, pray for those who are struggling. The effects of the pandemic has created and worsened many physical, emotional, mental, economic and social problems. Pray that God will move mightily in these situations, and bring hope and peace of mind. Pray that shortages in supply chains will be eased. Pray for the many families who are facing financial and accommodation difficulties at this time, and now face increased prices on food, fuel and other bills. In EBC, continue to remember David Wackett's family as they prepare for his funeral. Continue to pray for those who are unwell, in body or in spirit, that they may rest in God's care as they receive treatment and support. Thank God that we are able to make more use of our church building, especially as during this period of Advent. Thank God for all the meetings, services and outreach events that are planned for this year, and for the further plans that He has for our church. Thank Him for his continued guidance in our search for a new minister and for the "preach with a view" visit from Minister In Training Martin who was accompanied by his wife and children.
